According to recent data from the College Board, about 77% of students at faith-based colleges receive some form of financial aid. That's not just a small discount - we're talking about significant help that can make these schools surprisingly affordable.

FAFSA 2025-2026: Key Changes and Deadlines for Student Aid



Free Application for Federal Student Aid

The U.S. Department of Education has announced important updates for the 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Here's what students and families need to know:

Timeline and Availability

- The Department of Education has the 2025-26 FAFSA fully available.
- Final submission deadline is June 30, 2026, at 11:59 p.m.
- Corrections deadline is Sept.14, 2026, by 11:59 pm

Key Updates

■ The application maintains the streamlined format with 36 questions instead of the previous 108.

■ The form will cover financial aid for attendance between July 1, 2025, & June 30, 2026.

Important Tips:

- Have ready: 2023 tax returns (this is the tax year required for the 2025-2026 FAFSA).
- Create your StudentAid.gov account ahead of time to avoid processing delays.
- Check with individual schools for their specific deadlines, as they may differ from federal timelines.
- Apply as early as possible to maximize aid opportunities. The online application through fafsa.gov remains the easiest, fastest, and most accurate way to complete the FAFSA form.

4. How Firm a Foundation


The world as we understand it through science constantly changes. Research and theory that were taught as fact in one era can give way when new data is discovered in the next.

A good college is obliged to teach its students the latest in science and scholarly advances, but a Christian college will place the truths of science in the greater context of God's timeless


Truth. While keeping pace with the most current thinking on any subject, a Christian college will never be moved from the unchanging truth of providence by an intellectual fad.

even work for Christian colleges?"

Absolutely! This is another common misconception that needs addressing. Christian universities participate in federal financial aid programs just like any other accredited institution. The financial aid at these schools includes federal aid, institutional scholarships, and grants available to those who complete the FAFSA. In fact, skipping the FAFSA is one of the biggest mistakes families make - students missed out on at least \$4 billion in unclaimed federal grants for the 2023-24 academic year.

Here's what you'll find at Christian colleges

Merit-Based Scholarships: Many Christian colleges offer substantial academic scholarships for incoming freshmen. For example, some institutions provide merit awards ranging from \$12,000 per academic year, with opportunities for even more based on academic achievement.

Faith-Based Awards: These colleges often offer unique scholarships for students involved in ministry, missionary work, or church leadership. These aren't typically available at secular institutions.

Need-Based Aid: Don't assume you make too much money to qualify. Many private colleges are committed to making education accessible through various financial aid policies, and some even offer full-tuition scholarships based on both merit and need.

The numbers tell an interesting story. While private college tuition has increased over the past three decades just like tuition at state schools, Christian colleges have worked hard to offset these costs through generous aid packages. Many families end up paying significantly less than the sticker price.


Here's my advice

Don't rule out a great college based on the published tuition rate alone. Complete the FAFSA early (it's available October 1st for the following academic year), and reach out to the financial aid offices at your chosen schools. They often have additional institutional aid that isn't advertised, and they're usually more than happy to walk you through all your options.


Don't be afraid to ask for more. Both our daughters got more aid at the end of the process because I sat down with the finanical aid department and said, "This is what we need to make it work."

Remember, investing in your child's education at a Christian college isn't just about the academics - it's about fostering growth in faith and character while preparing for a career or ministry. And with the right financial strategy, it might be more within reach than you thought.

What is a Christian education?

Christian schools provide an environment where a child can grow "...in wisdom and stature and in favor with God and men" (Luke 2:52). Through a Christian education at the schools in the following pages, students will not only learn about the world around them, but will also cultivate a deep and lasting relationship with God.

The goal of any school is to educate children about life, the world, and their purpose in it. Christian education seeks to teach children about the world God created, how our faith is woven into each area of learning, and how to find purpose and meaning through God's Will for our life. Only through an understanding of God, His Word, and His works, can we know truth and show His love to those around us.

A Christian education isn't just having a Bible or religion class in addition to normal classes, but an integration of a biblical worldview into every area of study. In a science class, students may learn about how God's handiwork is seen in the natural laws and design of the world; in physical education, they may learn about setting a Christ-like example both on and off the field. Through these experiences, students learn that following God isn't limited to one area of life.

Consider this example: for most families, church is once a week. As a result, we can unknowingly infer that we only learn about God once a week. With a Christian education, children

learn that God doesn't only exist on Sunday, but is constantly at work in the world each and every day.

A Christian school seeks to build on what's taught at church and in the home. Building a faith that exists outside of the church and home is essential to establishing a deep and mature spiritual foundation later on in life. We know "...that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose" (Romans 8:28). Ultimately, the hope and prayer is that God guides your family to make the decision that will best help your child grow in his or her



faith and knowledge of Christ.

Can't Christians go to publi

Can't Christians go to public schools and turn out fine?

Indeed, they can. Just because a school is public doesn't mean it can't provide a good education and teachers who care about their students. However, keep in mind that the goal of the public school is to educate according to the world's standards and beliefs. As stated earlier, Christian schools integrate Christian morals and principles into each class. The whole atmosphere of a Christian school is one that both promotes and points students to the love of Christ. What's more, every teacher will seek to help your child grow, both academically and in their walk with Christ.

Christian schools hold students to both a higher level of academic achievement as well as accountability in their walk with God. They are challenged to achieve their fullest potential in school, and aren't just seen as a number. From a spiritual standpoint, they are encouraged to grow in their faith and ask the questions that help them understand why they believe what they believe.

The Barna group, a faith-based

research company, recently found that many church leaders in both Protestant and Catholic churches see public schools as a negative influence on a child's faith. Ultimately they concluded,

"Clergy view parents, churches, and Christian communities, as positive influences on a child's spiritual formation and development. However, children are spending most of their daytime weekday hours each at school, which is perceived by many church leaders as a negative influence on a child's spiritual formation. In fact, schools are ranked alongside a child's friends and peers as primarily negative influences—a view held by 61 percent of Protestant leaders and 65 percent of Catholic leaders. In some cases, the perceived negative influence of a child's school or friend group outweighs a perceived positive influence by double."

"While it is great that some churches have partnered with or served at local public schools for the purposes of outreach, the decision of where a Christian parent should send their child to school should take into account the whole-person formation

of the child," Brooke Hempell, Barna's senior vice president of research, says. "And if public schools are perceived to have a negative influence on the spiritual formation of a child, parents need guidance on how to navigate this decision."

Shouldn't we as Christians be "salt and light" in the public schools?

A Christian school shouldn't seek to shelter its students from the world, but rather to teach them how to transform it. Just as churches equip Christians to learn about God and show His love to others, a Christian school allows for a more hands-on approach to this purpose. A Christian education trains students to understand the truth in the Bible and then share their faith confidently with others. Learning how to defend their faith and effectively share the Gospel is what will allow people to change the world through Christ.

We're all human, and regardless of our background or upbringing we all need to experience the love of Christ. Children in a Christian school are no different. They can experience the same issues and have the same questions as those in a public school can. The difference is that in a Christian school, the focus of education is to draw students into a deeper and fuller understanding of God and the world He created.

Again, we understand that choosing a school for your children is a big decision and pray that God guides you to the best choice for your family.
