Thirty Hours a Week: Who Is Shaping Your Child?

Most kids spend more waking hours at school than anywhere else besides home. That's just reality. So it makes sense that parents in places like the Kansas City metro — from Overland Park to Lee's Summit, from Liberty to Olathe — are taking a careful look at where their children are sitting every day.

School shapes more than report cards. It shapes friendships. It shapes confidence. It shapes what a child believes about truth, right and wrong, even about God.

That's why more Christian parents are having honest conversations about education again.

A Noticeable Shift Toward Private Christian Schools

Across the country, private school enrollment has rebounded since the pandemic dip. Federal data released in

2024 shows about 4.7 million students enrolled in private K-12 schools nationwide — roughly one in ten American students. Religious schools, including Christian schools, make up the largest portion of that number.

Here in the Kansas City metro area, many campuses are seeing renewed interest. Some have waiting lists. Others have expanded classrooms or added staff. Families are asking questions they may not have asked five years ago.

At the same time, homeschooling

continues to grow. Recent estimates suggest between 3.5 and 4 million students nationwide are now educated at home — nearly double pre-2020 levels. For many families, the shift wasn't temporary. They found a rhythm and decided to stay with it.

Parents are not just reacting. They're thinking carefully about the kind of environment they want shaping their children.

What Makes Christian Education Different?

Let's keep this simple.

A Christian school isn't just a place where students take a Bible class once a day. At its best, it's a place where faith shows up in ordinary moments.

In a science class, a teacher might pause and say, "Look at the design in this." Psalm 19:1 comes to mind: "The heavens declare the glory of God." In history, students talk honestly about

human failure and redemption. On the basketball court, they're reminded that character matters more than trophies.

Luke 2:52 says Jesus grew "in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man." That's what many Christian schools aim for — growth in knowledge, yes, but also in maturity and faith.

And here's something parents quietly admit: church is usually once or twice a week. School is five days a week. If God is only mentioned on Sunday, kids can start to assume He belongs only there. A Christian school



reinforces what's taught at home and church, not in a heavy-handed way, but in everyday conversation.

What About Public Schools?

It's important to say this clearly: many strong believers come out of public schools. There are dedicated teachers in public districts across Kansas and Missouri who care deeply about their students.

But public schools operate in a broad framework designed to serve families of every belief system. They can't teach from a distinctly Christian foundation. That's simply how they're structured.

Christian schools, on the other hand, don't have to tiptoe around their faith. Teachers pray with students. They talk openly about Scripture. When questions about identity or morality come up, the Bible isn't off-limits.

Research from Barna continues to show that many clergy believe schools significantly influence a child's spiritual direction. Whether parents agree or

disagree with that assessment, it highlights something obvious: school is formative. It shapes hearts as well as minds.

So the real question isn't "Can my child survive in a public school?" Many do. The question is, "Where will my child be best supported in growing both academically and spiritually?"

A Brief Word on Homeschooling

Homeschooling deserves mention because it's no longer rare. In fact, in many church communities around Kansas City, you'll find thriving homeschool co-ops and hybrid programs.

For some families, teaching at home allows them to weave Scripture naturally into the day. Deuteronomy 6:6-7 speaks of impressing God's commands on our children as we sit at home and walk along the road. For homeschool parents, that verse feels very practical.

Of course, homeschooling requires time, structure and sacrifice. It's not a fit for everyone. But for families who feel called to it, it can be deeply rewarding.

The Financial Reality

Let's be honest: private Christian education costs money. That's usually the first hesitation parents voice.

But many schools across the Kansas City area offer financial aid, scholarships and payment plans. In some states, school-choice programs or education savings accounts help offset tuition. Families often piece together solutions they didn't initially see.

Psalm 50 reminds us that God owns "the cattle on a thousand hills." Parents sometimes share stories of unexpected bonuses, side jobs, or just creative budgeting that made it possible. Not easy — but possible.

Salt and Light

Some parents ask whether Christian students should remain in public schools to be "salt and light" (Matt. 5:13-16). That's a fair question.

A strong Christian school isn't meant to isolate students from the world. Ideally, it prepares them to engage it wisely. Students learn what they believe and why. They practice having respectful conversations. They wrestle with hard questions in a setting where Scripture is taken seriously.

No environment guarantees outcomes. Every child is different. Every family situation is different.

But the decision matters. Where your child spends those 30-plus hours each week will influence the way he or she sees the world.

So parents across Kansas City — and across the country — are pausing, praying and asking God for direction. As Romans 8:28 reminds us, He works in all things for the good of those who love Him.

Choosing a school isn't just about academics. It's about who your child is becoming. And that's worth careful thought.



School Choice in Missouri & Kansas

For Christian families considering private education, school choice programs in Missouri and Kansas could benefit you when paired with a local Christian school.

In Missouri, that pathway primarily runs through the MOScholars program. Established in 2021, MOScholars allows individuals and businesses to receive state tax credits for donating to approved Educational Assistance Organizations (EAOs). Those EAOs then award scholarships to eligible students.

Here's what that means at the school level: a participating Christian school partners with an EAO. Families apply through the scholarship organization, not directly through the state. If approved, the scholarship funds are

directed toward tuition at the Christian school.

Most participating Christian schools must meet accreditation standards and basic financial accountability requirements. Long-standing Christian schools typically already meet those benchmarks, which makes participation feasible without altering their religious mission or curriculum.

The scholarship does not usually cover full tuition. Instead, it reduces the cost. A family paying \$8,000 per year in tuition, for example, might see that obligation lowered significantly depending on eligibility and available funds. For many middle- and lower-income households, that reduction moves private education from unrealistic to manageable.

Kansas operates a narrower but similar structure through its Tax Credit for Low Income Students Scholarship Program. Donors receive state tax credits for contributing to scholarship granting organizations, which in turn award scholarships to qualifying students.

To participate, a Christian school must be accredited and comply with health and safety standards. Eligible families — typically those from lower-income households whose children previously attended public schools — apply through a scholarship organization. Approved funds are then applied to tuition at the Christian school.

In both states, the program functions as a bridge. The Christian school maintains its faith-based instruction,



daily prayer, and biblical worldview integration. The scholarship mechanism simply assists with affordability.

The financial dynamic is straightforward: these programs do not replace tuition, but they soften it. For Christian parents who value both aca-

demical rigor and spiritual formation, that financial support can make sustained enrollment possible — not just for a year, but for the duration of a child's education.

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
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Teleios Academy
